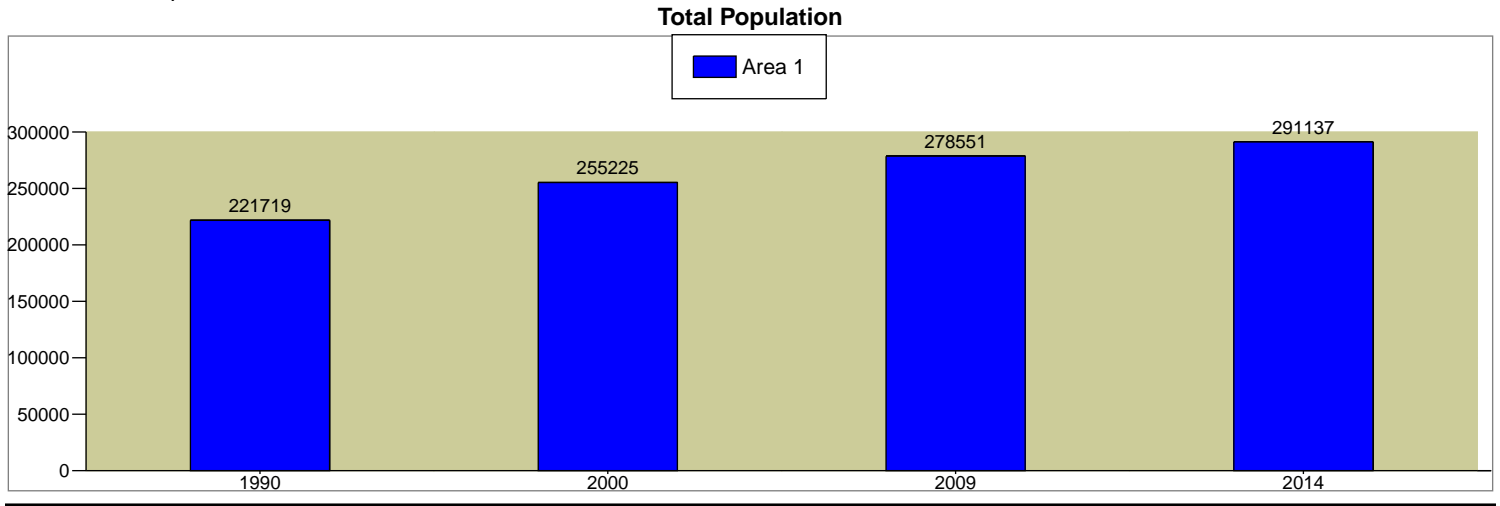

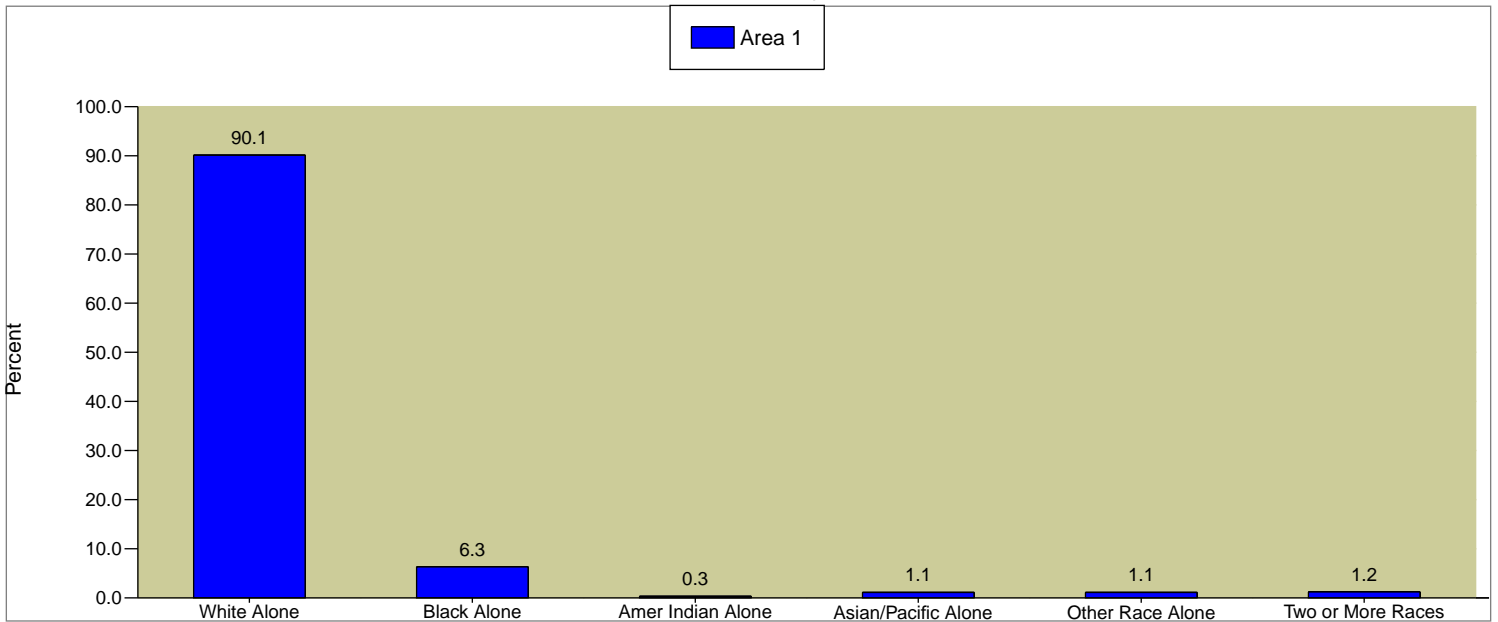

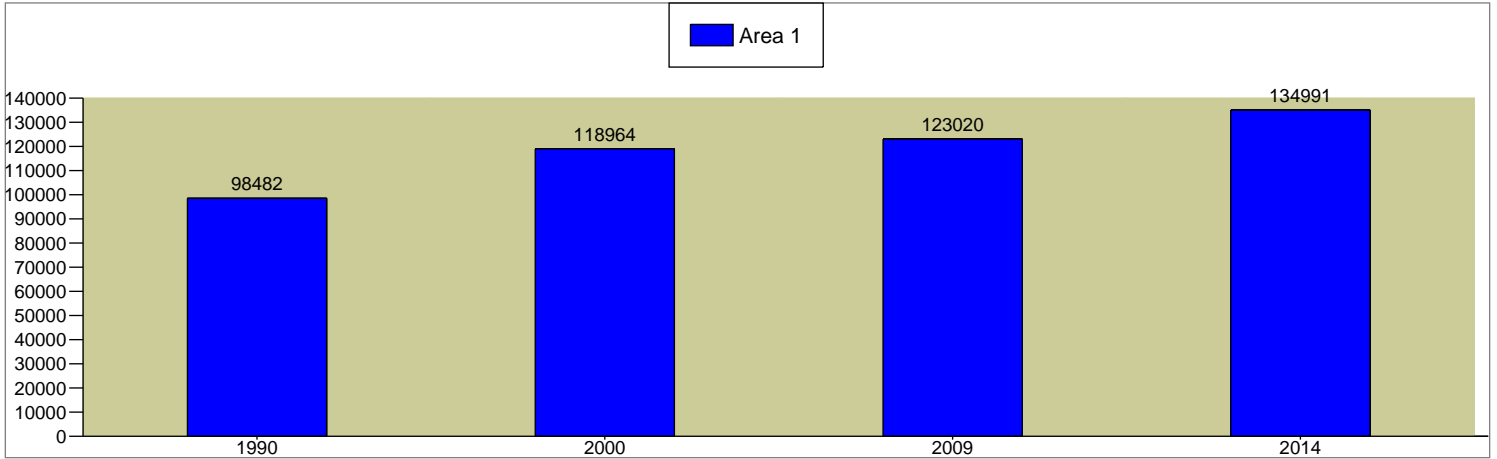

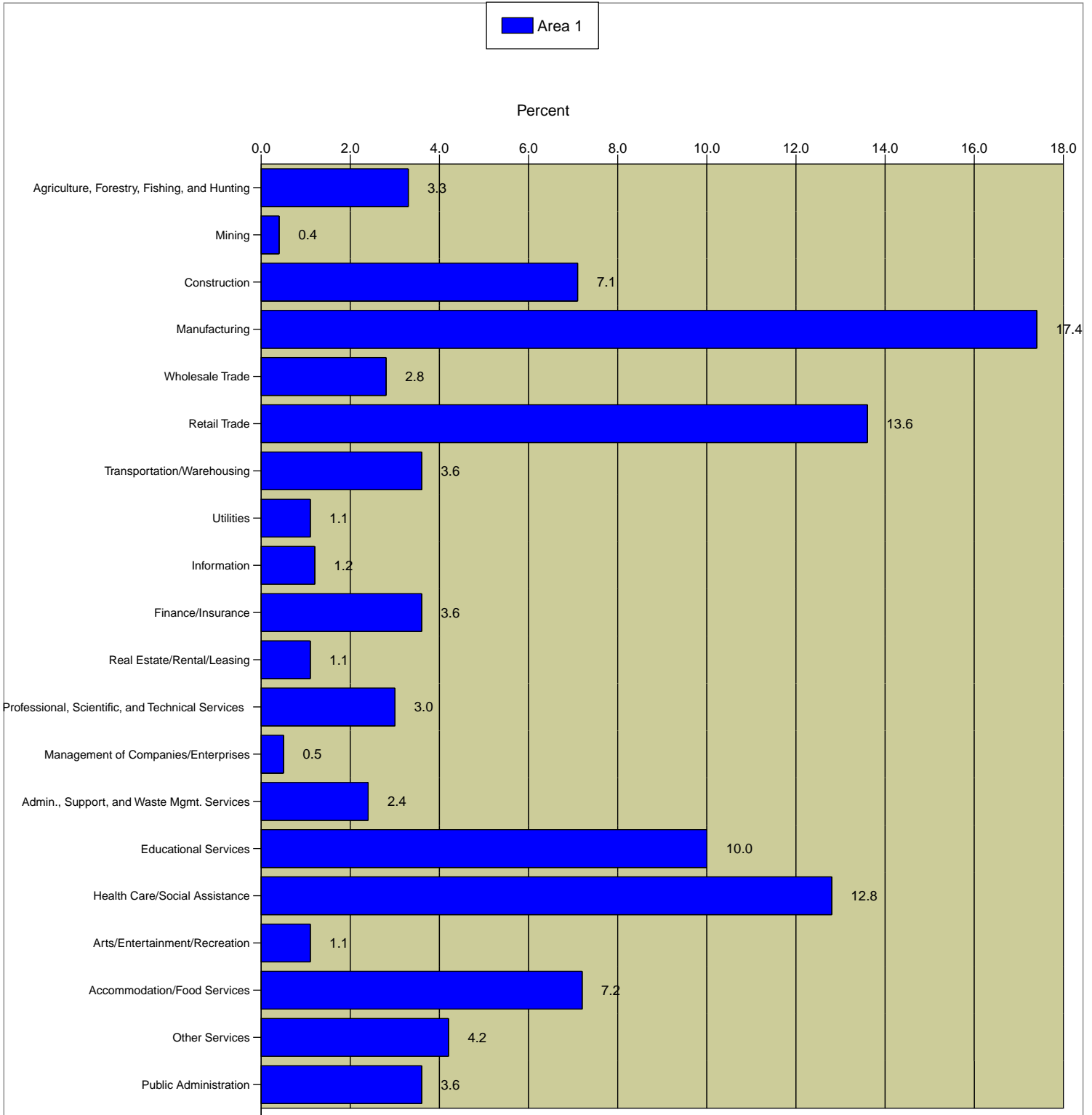
Total Civilian Employed Population 16+

2009 Employed Civilian Population 16+ by Industry

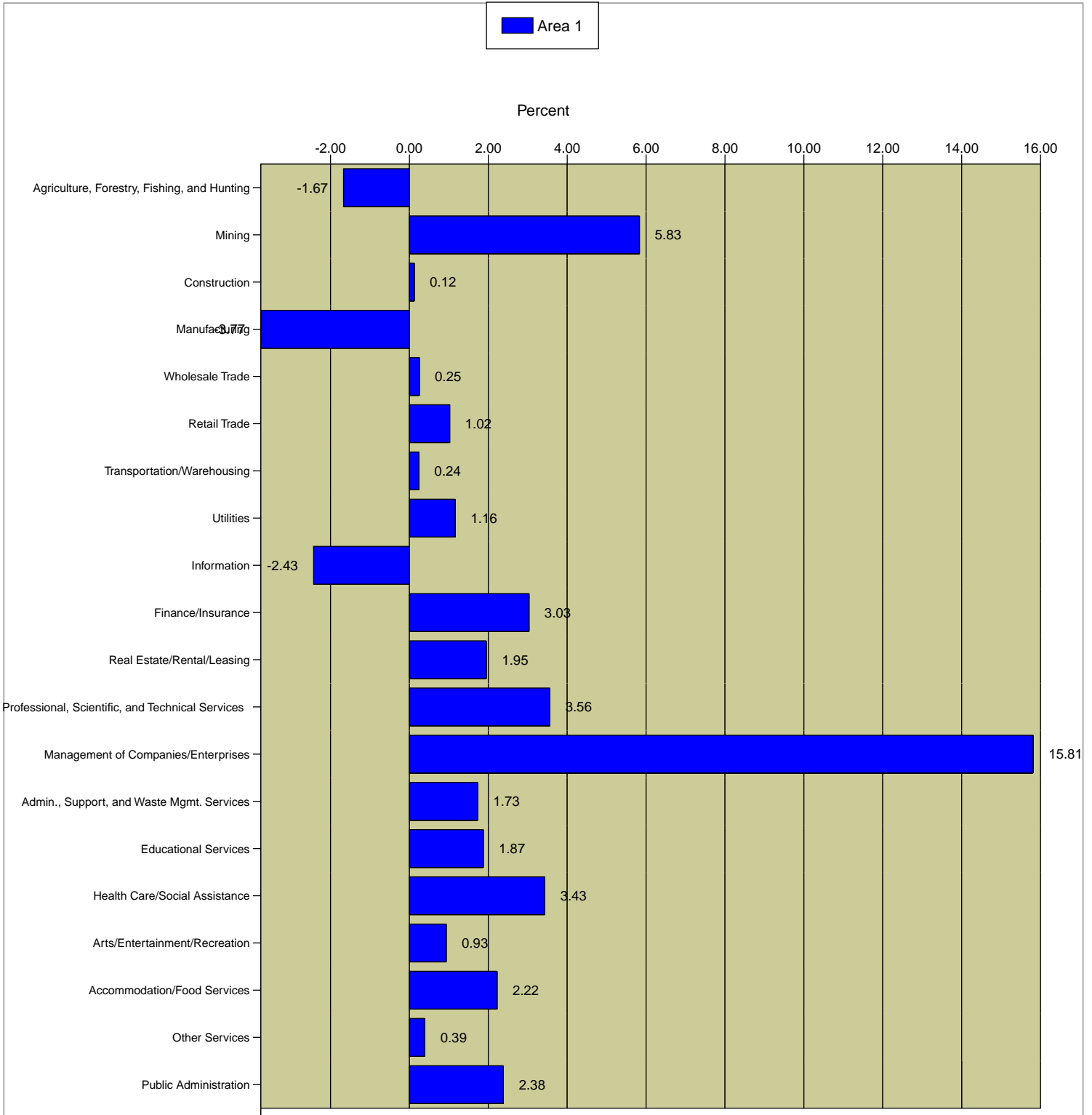

2000 - 2009 Population by Industry Annual Rate

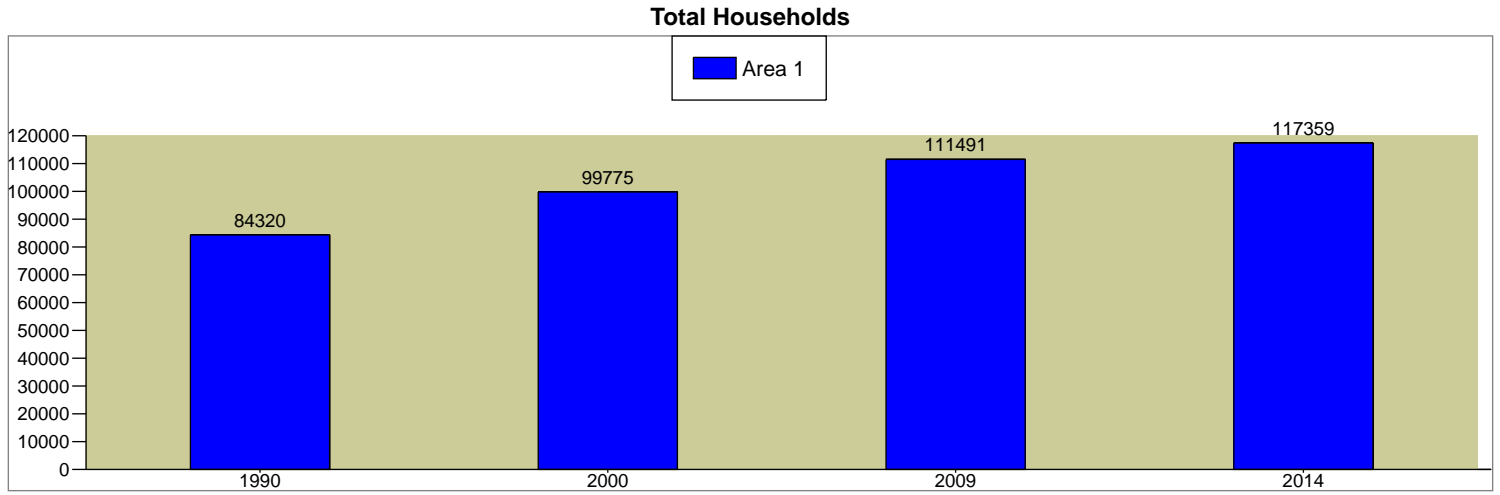

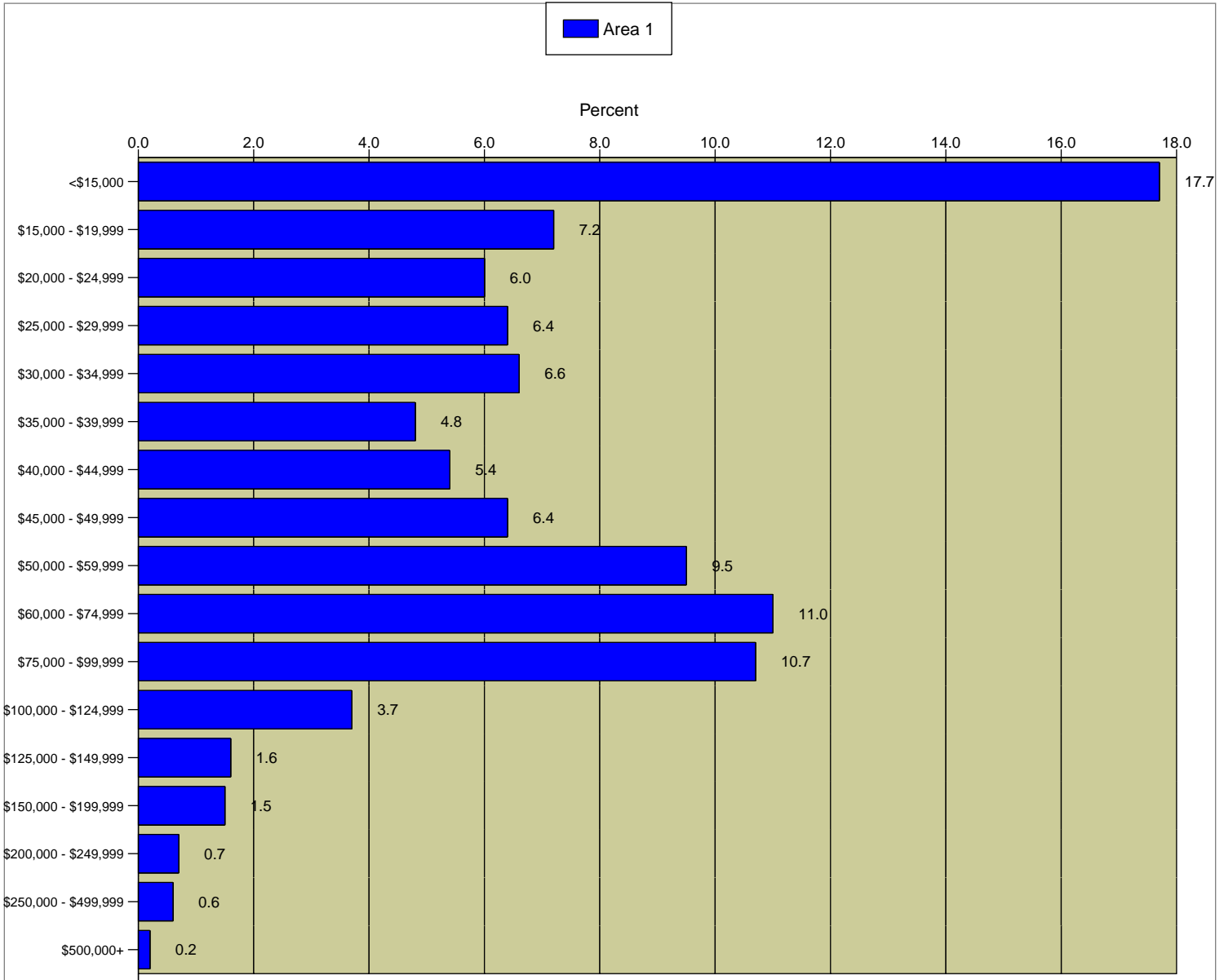

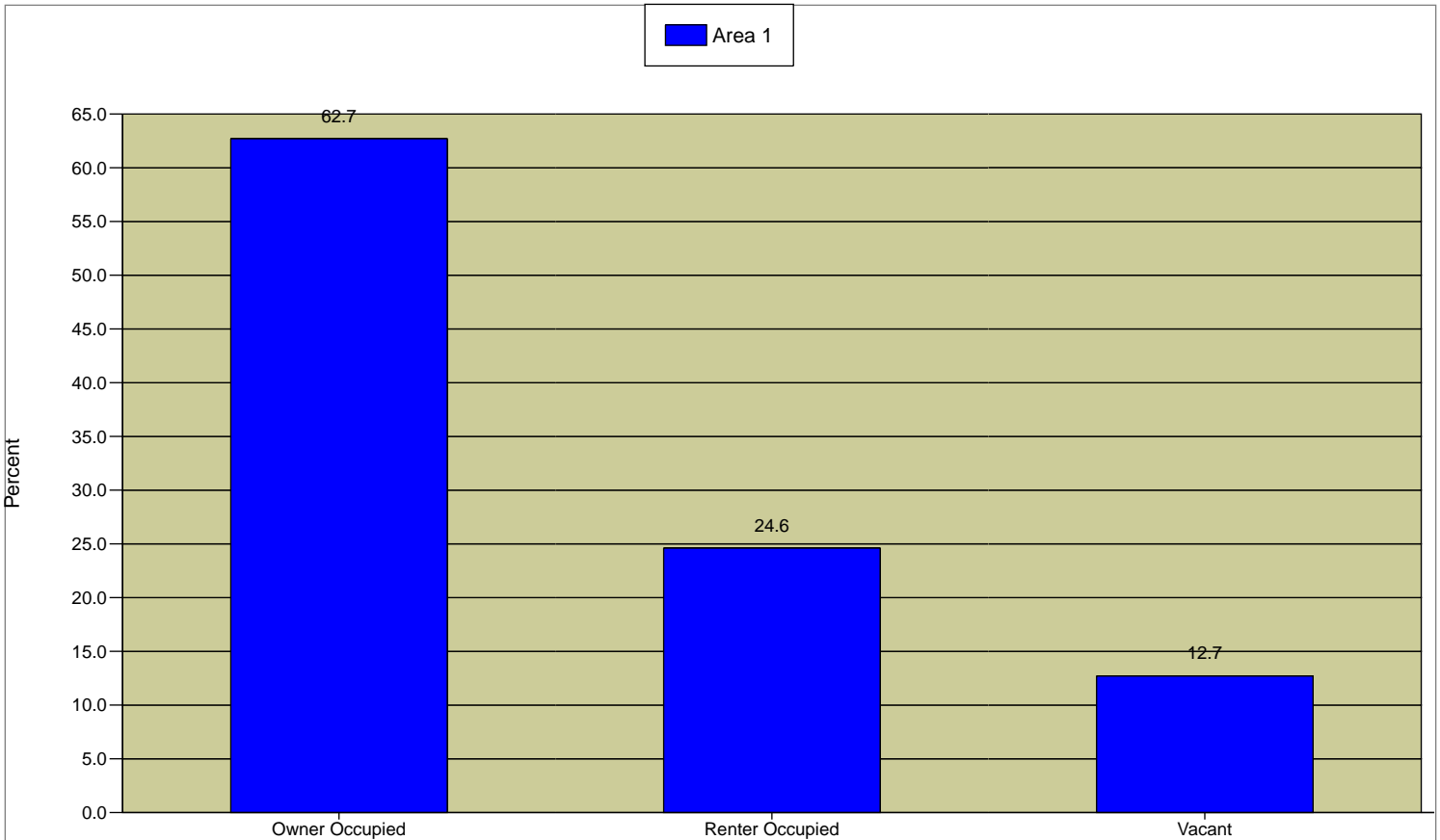
