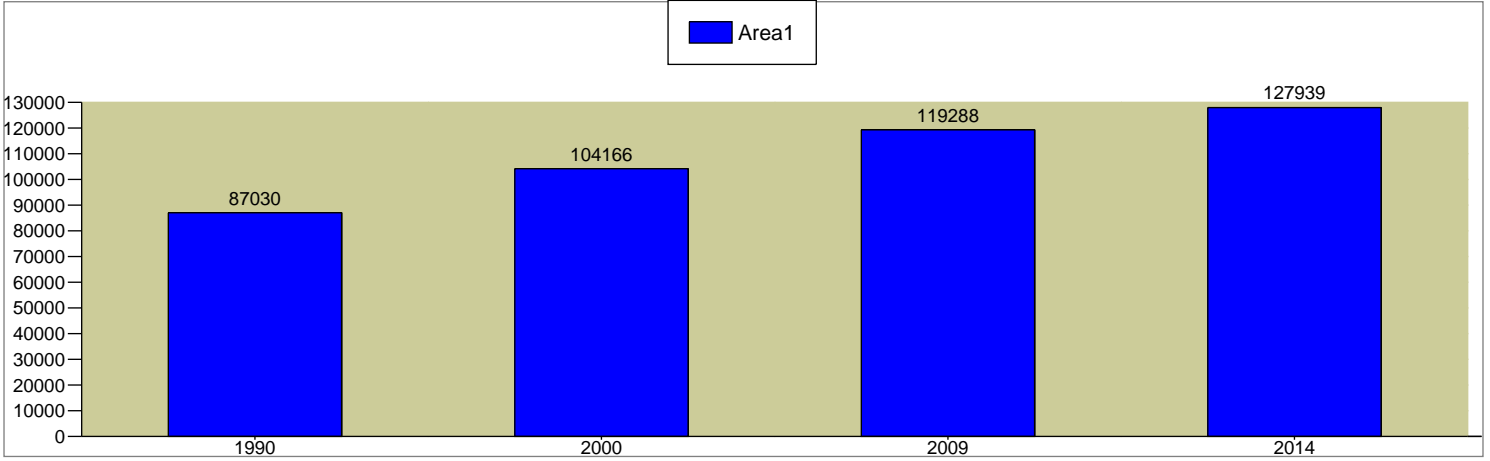

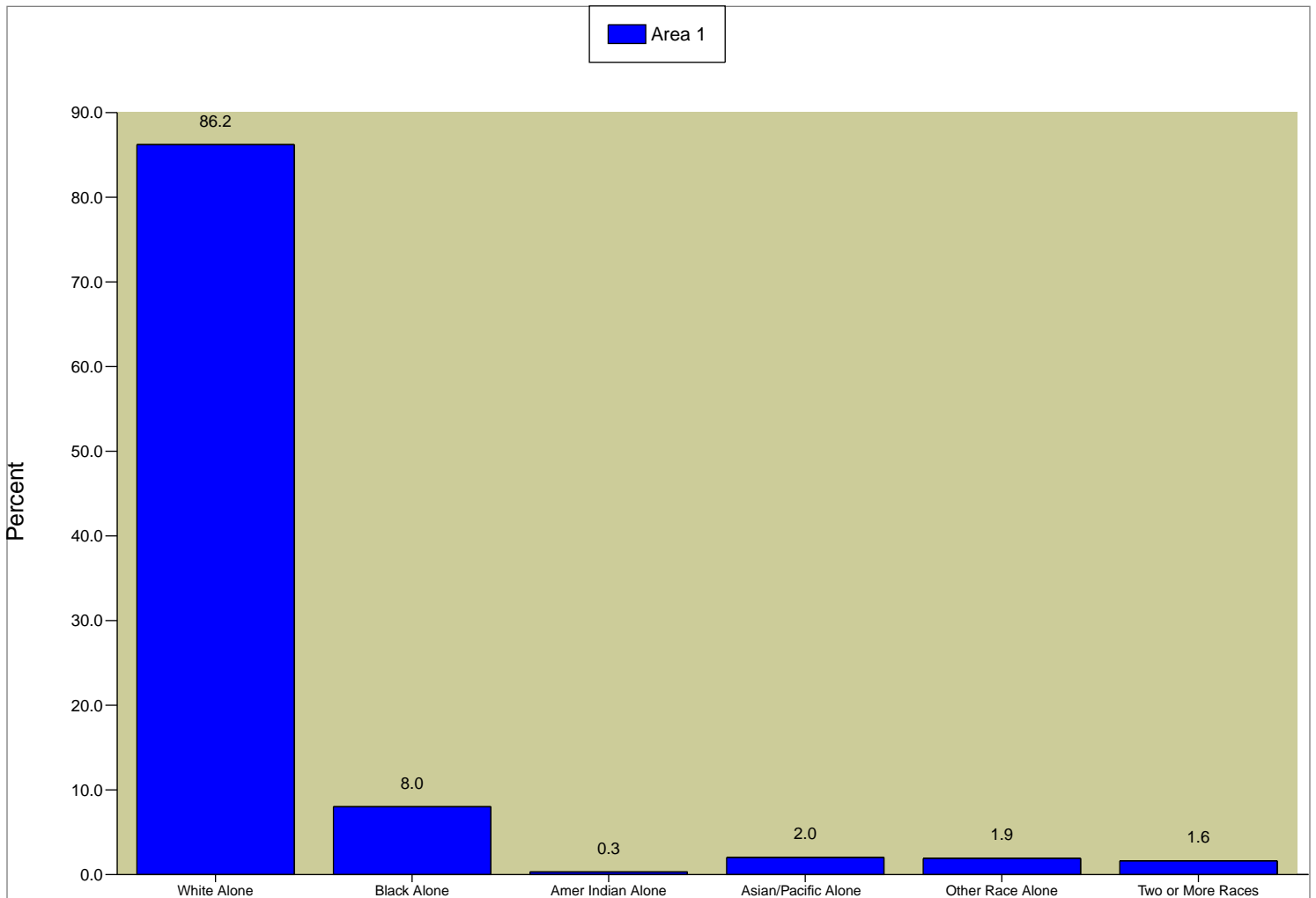

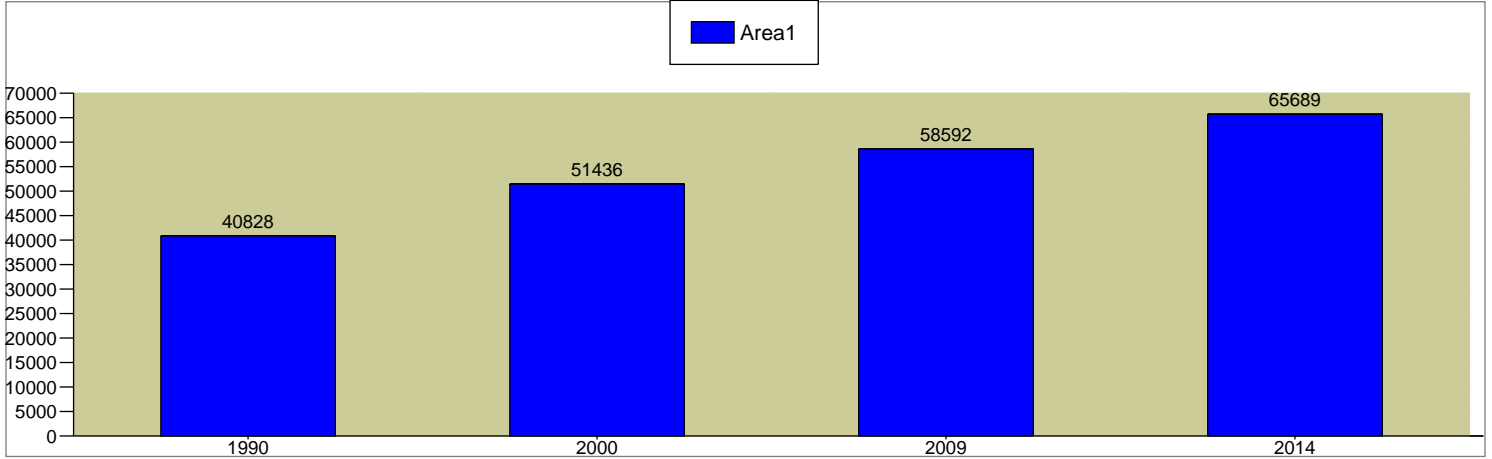

Total Civilian Employed Population 16+



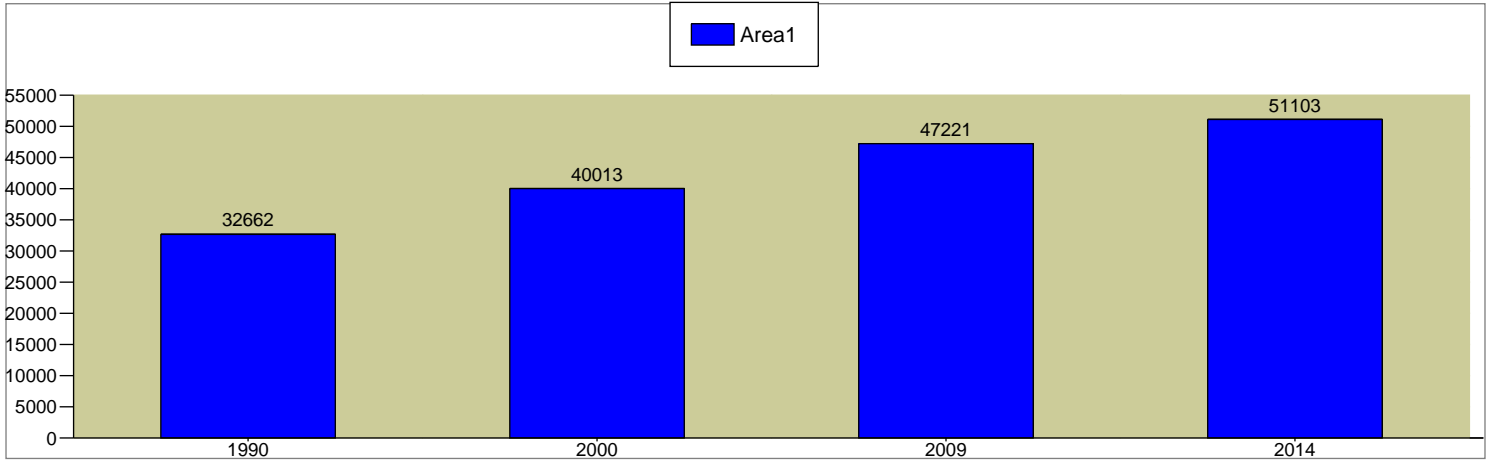
